

Black Cliffs / Svörtuklettur

Info and maps



Access:

The Black Cliffs are accessed from road no. 360 by taking a left turn exactly 1.35 km after having turned onto road no. 360 from road no. 36.

The shortest way from Reykjavik is to take road no. 1, northbound, and turn right into road no. 36. in town Mosfellsbær. From road no. 36, turn right onto road no. 360.

Fishing rules (please read carefully):

- 1) Fishing hours are limited to 12 hrs. per day, in the period from 8am-11pm.
- 2) Please park at the designated parking spot by the cabin. No driving on the sand-beach or other off road driving.
- 3) Please do not pass the rivermouth to the north as the beat ends at the rivermouth.
- 4) Please do not leave any cigarettes, flies, tippet material or other trash at the beat.
- 5) If you notice any unauthorized persons fishing the beats, please notify the supervisors.
- 6) Please be respectful of the summerhouse owners and guests. It is a privilege for us fishermen to be able to fish such a great beat as the Black Cliffs. For that to continue, fishermen and summerhouse owners must live in harmony.
