

VILLINGAVATN – INFO AND MAPS

The Villingavatn beat (Fish Partner beat 3) is the southmost beat in Lake Thingvallavatn. It is divided into three smaller beats, beats A-C, and Lake Villingavatn, beat D.

The beats are accessed from road no. 360 through the farm Villingarvatn. The shortest way from Reykjavík is to take road no. 1 (eastbound), turn left onto road no. 435 and turn right onto road no. 360. An alternative route is road no. 1 (eastbound), turn left onto road no. 35, again left onto road no. 36 and finally left onto road no. 360.

To access the beats, fishermen must call the beats supervisors to open an electrical gate.

Fishing rules (please read carefully):

- 1) Fishing hours are limited to 12 hrs. per day, in the period from 8am-11pm.
- 2) Please park at the designated parking spot. **No driving on the sand-beach** or other off road driving.
- 3) Please do not leave any cigarettes, flies, tippet material or other trash at the beat.
- 4) If you notice any unauthorized persons fishing the beats, please notify the supervisors.
- 5) Please be respectful of the summerhouse owners and guests. It is a privilege for us fishermen to be able to fish such a great beat as Villingavatn. For that to continue, fishermen and summerhouse owners must live in harmony.

Beat A

The mouth of river Villingavatnsá. The beat stretches from the fence west of Villingarvatnsá to the parking on the beach. This is one of the best brown trout beats in Lake Thingavallavatn. The beat is only fished with **two rods** and all brown trout shall be released. It is fly-fishing only.

Beat B

From the parking on the beach to Hellisvík in the east. Two points are on the beat which are usually the best spots. The beat is only fished with **two rods** and all brown trout shall be released. It is fly-fishing only.

Beat C

From Hellisvík to Steingrímsstöð power plant. The beat is under big cliffs and some spots are hard to access. However, there are several coves along the shore with sand beaches which one can fish from. The beat holds both brown trout and arctic char. Rod limitation is **six rods**. Until 1 June it is fly-fish only. From 1 June spinners and worm are allowed. All brown trout shall be released.



Beat D

Lake Villingavatn is beat D. Despite being small, lake Villingavatn is the home to some big brown trout. The lake has **four rod** limitation. The lake is split into two beats, beat D-1 on the west bank and beat D-2 on the east bank. Each beat is fished with two rods. The lake is fly-fish only and catch and release.
